Secretary's Report: Adoption of 6/22/22 meeting minutes postponed to next meeting.

Project Updates:

Agricultural Programs – Amanda Fargo Johnson reported on the updates for: Application to CTDOAG – January 18, 2023 - Climate Smart Farming: Agriculture and Forestry Grant to provide subgrants to farmers to implement soil health and clean energy or equipment hubs and to implement additional equipment hubs across the state. **Motion:** To develop the grant for application that is due in January **Motion made by:** Tyra Penn-Gesek **Seconded by:** Rick Huntley **Voted:** Unanimously

RDBG 2023 -2024 is due in February or March and application will be made for the extension of Jillian's work in affordable farming. Patagonia grant possibility for capacity building. Eastern Ct Tourism Grant a possibility for continuation of Air Line Trail planning work.

Environmental Program:

Jeanne Davies reported on that the affordable farm project report and video are available and asked that all send to their respective municipalities. RC&D is also participating in a USDA grant obtained by the Town of Thompson to develop a small business support system center. RC&D will be focusing on education and outreach.

Amanda reported RBDG Grant was awarded by USDA Rural Development for \$90,000 (to continue the CT Farm Energy Program, FarmUP and Veteran FarmUP programs) as well as USDA Rural Development awarded us in 2022 with a REDA grant for \$100,000 to provide renewable energy assessments and assistance to CT Farms, and our consultant for the project is EnSave.

Financial Overview – Investment Funds:

Investment funds remain with Raymond James but our advisor has been switched to our original Liberty Bank advisor.

Membership, Meetings 2023 and Bylaws:
